Announcements:

Small Wonder Area Convention will be from March 13-15, 2020 in Wilmington. Smallwonderarea.org

RD Report:

CAR Reports will be posted on www.na.org/conference and will be available for sale on Nov. 26. Orders can be placed starting Friday Nov. 22 at the NA webstore.

The RD and RDA will be conducting workshops on a first come, first serve basis when they return from the CAR workshop in New Hampshire. The RD and RDA will go over the report with the RCM's, and the Area needs to decide how it would like the RCM's to present the report to the GSR's, either during an Area Service or in a separate workshop.

The second batch of review and input drafts for the SPAD book have been posted. We will need to review and give feedback between now and March 1st. www.na.org/spad

The WCNA 2021 has begun actively planning for Melbourne, Australia. Currently aiming for September 9-12, 2021. Due to Australia's strict immigration policies it is suggested that anyone wishing to attend should be begin the visa application process in September 2020.

It has been in discussion at Region as to whether the funds for the Zonal meetings be handled by a separate Treasurer position or be handled by the Zonal Secretary. Funds for Zonal are currently low, as it's currently just the travel expenses. A new position would require more funds as it would be another person in need of travel expenses.

Convention:

The FSRCNA is November 29-December 1. I hope everyone is registered and attending.

On November 26 they will be stuffing the Convention packages starting at 6pm at the hotel. All volunteers are welcome to come participate.

Public Relations:

Susquehanna Area will be receiving a billboard on Route 40 in Joppatowne at the end of this month. The billboard will cost \$1900 and be up for 8 weeks and will be at the intersection on Rt. 40 and Rt. 152. The motion passed at the November Off-Month after being tabled in October.

PR is planning a service learning day for 2020 and wants Area input on topics of interest for the event.

PR is currently in the process of preparing to handle the Zoom meetings at regional. They were running tests at Off Month. A policy motion would need to be made for them to officially take on that responsibility.

Special Events:

Special Events has been working to update their policy and would like input on item #13 which reads:

SEC's from each area will consider the 11th Tradition by not posting event about NA on the internet (i.e. Facebook, Myspace) since profiles for such networking sites include full names and photographs of individuals. To: Will not allow anyone to handle tickets or money except SASE members and Susquehanna Area Narcotics Anonymous members approved by the committee.

Amend line 9 from: The committee is responsible for setting the price of each event. Any event with a market price exceeding \$15 must be approved by the ASC.

To: The committee is responsible for setting the price for each event.

Amend line 10 from: Committee is responsible for setting the price of refreshments at all functions. Sodas will be brand name and sold for 50cents a can

To: Committee is responsible for setting the price of refreshments at all functions.

Amend line 16 from:

SASE will keep a budget of \$500 for expenses of putting on events, this budget is to include printing flyers, printing tickets, rent for event locations, refreshments, and DJ s and other venues

To: SASE will maintain a balance of \$1900 in it's bank account in order to avoid monthly fees. All money from ticket sales or NA group donations will be deposited as soon as possible.
