October 16th, 2021,9:32 am: Via Facebook Messenger:

"Good morning Derek, I am the SASC Policy chair and I received an inquiry regarding promotion of events inside the Susquehanna Area of Narcotics Anonymous and the 7th Tradition. Are the proceeds of your functions being passed onto the World as a donation. I was hoping for some clarity, Thank you."

Derek's response:

"Good afternoon, is this in response to what we do with the money from the fundraiser we hold?"

My reply:

"Yes, we were approached as a subcommittee with concerns over speaker jams being held in the Susquehanna Area with any attempts to work with Special events in the Area?" "I did not know the answer, and why I reached out. Thank you, have a great day"

Derek D's response:

"So all the money we raise goes to put on our convention. You attended one of our events last year. Our first convention was this past September. We raised \$6000 to buy literature from World. Our area will be receiving close to 500 dollars in basic texts that we will be donating to H & I for them to get the books into facilities that do not have them."

I thanked him for the link and followed up with this question:

"Has "Unity is a must" convention board been in contact with Free State Region Special Events when scheduling events in the Area?"

Derek's response:

"No worries, honestly, last year was our first convention and we started in the pandemic. The body is made up of members all across the country. We held fundraisers in several states. Our communication was not the best with everything we did but are working to improve on that this year. Our second convention will be held in San Diego this year. We will attend the next area meeting and give a presentation, if there can be some time for it."


