All Tally Sheets were submitted to the RD for the WSC.

- 2. Region operated this month using "consensus-based decision making". They are using the same guidelines as the Autonomy Zone and the WSC.
- 3. Region agreed to operate using "consensus-based decision making' for the next 2 on month meetings. They will hold a vote at the August Region on how to continue to move forward.
- 4. A member brought the idea of the Region hosting a "Baltimore Area 40th Anniversary". Baltimore Area was against this idea as it did not formulate from their area. There was discussion around the fact that the Region was originally called the Baltimore Area and that the Region should host the event.
 The task team was not formed as they did not have consensus; however, Baltimore Area was
 - taking back the area to discuss. One option was for the Baltimore Area to host the event. The second option was for the Baltimore Area to have the Region fund and participate in hosting the event.
- 5. An update was provided on the zones. The "east coast" regions have formed a task team to look into combining zones into one large zone. The North East Zone has not committed to participating.

A discussion was held regarding funding for the 40th anniversary celebration for the Baltimore Area. A straw poll held regarding the issue. Question for straw poll: who is in favor of Region funding and participating in hosting the event? No one in favor of this.
