**PR:** Pete B reporting.

Have not given out many packets. Some drops open, John not doing drops any more, and many drops are now open (18). Do not need literature this month. Making a motion to carry over money. Did Christmas in the Grove event. Went well. NEFA has asked that we get our own swag. Their vendors are 4 Print, Vista Print, and All 4 Promos. Swag includes backpacks, lollipops, key tags, postcards with PR code for website and hotline, pens, notepads, fridge magnets with QR codes, Chapstick, and Narcan. Will need help ordering.

Pete advised that he will be entering a motion, and asked for a second.

Bryan asked about set up fee for QR code key tags – will we still have to pay if NEFA already set up? Pete advised that we will, as we would be a new client.

JJ asked if Pete's only goal is the key tag or if he would want other merchandise? Pete advised that right now, he would like to focus on key tags, and maybe Narcan since it is free.

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JJ asked if Pete has events that he is planning to attend. Pete shared that he went to the event Christmas in the Grove. He advised that he went to an event in Delta, but it was a craft fair and no one picked up any information. Pete added that at least NA had a public showing.

Sylvia advised that she would prefer to take it back to her homegroup and let the members have a say. John stated that he agrees with this as well.

Jess stated that this discussion has been held for the last couple of area meetings, and the topic has had ample opportunity to be discussed with home group members.

Bryan clarified that the key tag initiative is due to region not providing printed schedules. Pete agreed and indicated that this would be a one-time expense.

Steven asked when the last time literature drops were made. He asked if Pete is asking to spend money that is currently sitting in his budget not being used.

Marshall clarified that Pete is requesting a one-time expense and will amend the PR policy. He added that he is unsure that the PR policy would need to be changed if it is a one-time thing. Pete advised that other areas are moving in a similar direction, and anticipates that he may need to request a budget increase.

Rob stated that the policy states that PR does not accept contributions outside of NA. He suggested that the Narcan, though free, may be considered an outside contribution.
